



## Getting Started with TrusCont Secure Flash Drive (TSFD)

### Process

1. Create an account on TrusCont server
2. Download and install TrusCont TSFD Protection Toolkit
3. Follow the instructions to produce your first protected USB Flash Drive



### Detailed Instructions

1. Creating an account on TrusCont server
  - 1.1 Open internet explorer and go to TrusCont website (<http://www.truscont.com>)
  - 1.2 Click on the 'register' link and fill in the registration form.
2. Download and install TrusCont TSFD Protection Toolkit
  - 2.1 Open internet explorer and go to TrusCont website (<http://www.truscont.com>)
  - 2.2 Login to your account and go to the 'downloads' section.
  - 2.3 Download TrusCont TSFD Protection Toolkit.
  - 2.4 Save the installation file to your local HDD and double click it to start the installation
  - 2.5 Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the installation
3. Instructions for Producing Protected Recording Content on TSFDs
  - 3.1 Open TrusCont TSFD Protection Toolkit
  - 3.2 Select 'Create a New Project' and then click next
  - 3.3 Add files and folders to your project
  - 3.4 On the right panel check the files you wish to protect then click next
  - 3.5 Type a volume label for your new protected TSFD then click next
  - 3.6 Connect one or more TSFD devices to your computer's USB ports
  - 3.7 Select 'Start Duplicating' and click next
  - 3.8 Select your target TSFD device from the dropdown list box. If you wish to record more than one TSFD check the 'Batch mode' option. Click next to proceed.
  - 3.9 Check the 'Read Only Removable' check box if you wish to have your files on a read-only partition. Check the CD-ROM option to store your files on a virtual CD-ROM partition. CD-ROM partitions fully support the Autorun/Autoplay feature and are also read-only.
  - 3.10 Click next to start the duplication process.
